Pursuant to Article 9(1), point (a), of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 (1), the Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union (2) are hereby amended as follows:

On page 374,

the Explanatory note to CN subheadings '8701 91 10 to 8701 95 90 Other, of an engine power'

is replaced by the following text:

These subheadings include so-called all-terrain vehicles (ATV), designed to be used as tractors. These four-wheeled vehicles are fitted with a motor-car-type steering system (based on the Ackerman principle) controlled by a handlebar, equipped with a coupling device of any kind, for example, a towing hitch, and feature the technical characteristics enabling them to haul or push a load, or to tow a non-braked trailer of twice their own dry weight (that is, the weight of the vehicle without any liquids, passengers or cargo) or more.

The following features are indicative of the technical characteristics generally applicable to the vehicles that fall under these subheadings:

- brakes on all wheels;
- an automatic clutch and a reverse gear;
- an engine specially designed for use in difficult terrain and capable in low ratio of delivering sufficient power;
- power transmission to the wheels by drive shafts;
- tyres having a deep tread design, suitable for rough terrain.

The towing capacity can be proved by technical documentation, user manual or certificate from the manufacturer or from a national authority, specifying exactly in kilograms the towing capacity of the all-terrain vehicle, as well as its dry weight.

Where those vehicles are, furthermore, in accordance with the explanatory note to subheading 8701 91 10, they are to be classified according to their engine power, under subheadings 8701 91 10, 8701 92 10, 8701 93 10, 8701 94 10 or 8701 95 10, as agricultural or forestry tractors. Otherwise, they fall under subheadings 8701 91 90, 8701 92 90, 8701 93 90, 8701 94 90 or 8701 95 90.'

Pursuant to Article 9(1)(a) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 (1)(1), the Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union (2) are hereby amended as follows:

On page 51, in the Explanatory note to CN heading '0712 Dried vegetables, whole, cut, sliced, broken or in powder, but not further prepared', the following new last paragraph is inserted:

0712

'Heat treatment with the aim of reducing microorganisms (e.g. with hot steam) on the product surface is allowed in this heading, provided that the products retain the character of dried vegetables, not further prepared.'

On page 52, in the Explanatory note to CN heading '0714 Manioc, arrowroot, salep, Jerusalem artichokes, sweet potatoes and similar roots and tubers with high starch or inulin content, fresh, chilled, frozen or dried, whether or not sliced or in the form of pellets; sago pith', the following new last paragraph is inserted:

0714

'Heat treatment with the aim of reducing microorganisms (e.g. with hot steam) on the product surface is allowed for the dried products of this heading, provided that the products retain the character of dried roots and tubers, not further prepared than by the methods allowed for in this heading.'

Pursuant to Article 9(1)(a) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 (¹), the Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union (²) are hereby amended as follows:

On page 31, in the Explanatory note to subheadings '0302 33 10 and 0302 33 90 Skipjack or stripe-bellied bonito' the last paragraph is replaced by the following text:

0302 33 10 and 0302 33 90

'These subheadings do not cover the Atlantic or belted bonitos (*Sarda sarda*), which have oblique bands on their backs. These fish, if fresh or chilled, are classified in subheading 0302 49 90.'

On page 32, after the Explanatory note to CN subheading '0302 43 90 Brisling or sprats (Sprattus sprattus)' the following text is inserted:

'0302 49 90 Other

This subheading also includes:

- 1. the Atlantic or belted bonitos (*Sarda sarda*), which have oblique bands on their backs, as well as all other *Sarda* species;
- 2. capelin (Mallotus villosus).'

On page 33, in the Explanatory note to subheading '0302 89 90 Other' the text is replaced by the following text:

'0302 89 90 Other

The saltwater fish falling in this subheading include:

- 1. whiting-pout (Trisopterus luscus and Trisopterus esmarki);
- 2. comber (Serranus spp.) and grouper (Epinephelus spp.);
- 3. striped mullet (Mullus barbatus) and red mullet or surmullet (Mullus surmuletus);
- 4. gurnard or gurnet (Trigla, Eutrigla, Aspitrigla, Lepidotrigla and Trigloporus spp.);
- 5. scorpion fish (Scorpaena spp.);
- 6. sea lamprey (Petromyzon marinus);
- 7. garfish or needle-fish (Belone belone) and weevers (Trachinus spp.);
- 8. smelt (Osmerus spp.);
- 9. fish of the species Kathetostoma giganteum.'

On page 34, in the Explanatory note to subheading '0305 63 00 Anchovies (Engraulis spp)' the text is replaced by the following text:

'0305 63 00 Anchovies (Engraulis spp.)

The anchovies in brine belonging to this subheading have undergone no further preparation. They are put up in small barrels or jars or often in hermetically sealed cans without having undergone any heat treatment after closure of the can.'

Pursuant to Article 9(1)(a) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 (¹)(1), the Explanatory Notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union (²) are hereby amended as follows:

On page 111, the Explanatory note to subheading '2403 99 10 Chewing tobacco and snuff' is replaced by the following text:

'2403 99 10 Chewing tobacco and snuff (nasal tobacco)

Chewing tobacco is tobacco in the form of rolls, sticks, strips, cubes and blocks, which is specially prepared to be chewed but not smoked and which is put up for retail sale. The tobacco is generally not ground.

Snuff (nasal tobacco) is tobacco in dry powder or grain form, which has been specially treated so that it can be taken as snuff (nasal tobacco) but not smoked or taken by mouth.

Provided that they satisfy the above conditions, products consisting in part of substances other than tobacco are classified in this subheading.'

Prior notification of a concentration (Case M.10676 - NEXT / WP / PINK) Candidate case for simplified procedure

(Text with EEA relevance)

(2022/C 151/11)

1. On 25 March 2022, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (1).

This notification concerns the following undertakings:

- Next Holdings Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of Next plc ('Next', United Kingdom),
- Warburg Pincus LLC ('WP', United States),
- Pink Topco Limited ('Pink', Jersey), controlled by WP.

Next and WP will acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) and 3(4) of the Merger Regulation joint control of Pink, currently solely controlled by WP.

The concentration is accomplished by way of purchase of shares.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are the following:
- Next is a UK-based retailer selling Next-branded menswear, womenswear, childrenswear, lingerie, footwear, homeware and furniture, gifts and flowers, both in-store and online, including in the EEA,
- WP is a US-based member-owned global private equity firm, whose investments are focused on a range of sectors in North America, Europe and Asia, including industrial, energy, financial services, healthcare and technology, media and telecommunications, and consumer goods, including retail sale of apparel and footwear,
- Pink is the owner of the Reiss brand, which is active in the sale of Reiss-branded menswear, womenswear, footwear and accessories, both in-store and online, including in the EEA.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.

Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (2) it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.
